

$\pi$  Concepts of Math (COM) is a Teacher and Learning non-accountability Math assessment for Kindergarten to drive instruction. It is an option at grade 1 as well. Teachers will administer the COM and enter the data in Illuminate. ~ The OLPA is the MDE non-accountability assessment, similar to the MCA Math and Reading. It is unknown if MDE will be offering this assessment beyond this year. Schools may choose to administer the Optional Local Purpose Assessment (OLPA) in math up to two times during the window for grades 3-8.

 English Language Proficiency assessment: ACCESS (from World-class Instructional Design & Assessment Consortium—WIDA). Online administration except Kindergarten ACCESS, Alternate ACCESS (Special Ed), and grades 1- 5 writing domain, which are paper administrations.

\* High School MCA Science will be administered to all students *completing* Life Science credit (grades 9-12).

\*\* For grades 9-12, the Science MTAS should be administered when the student completes instruction in the life science standards as identified by the Essence Statements for the MTAS. The IEP team determines the most appropriate year for a high school student to take the Science MTAS.
