Question: How often are caring adult behaviors present within Keewaydin Middle School?

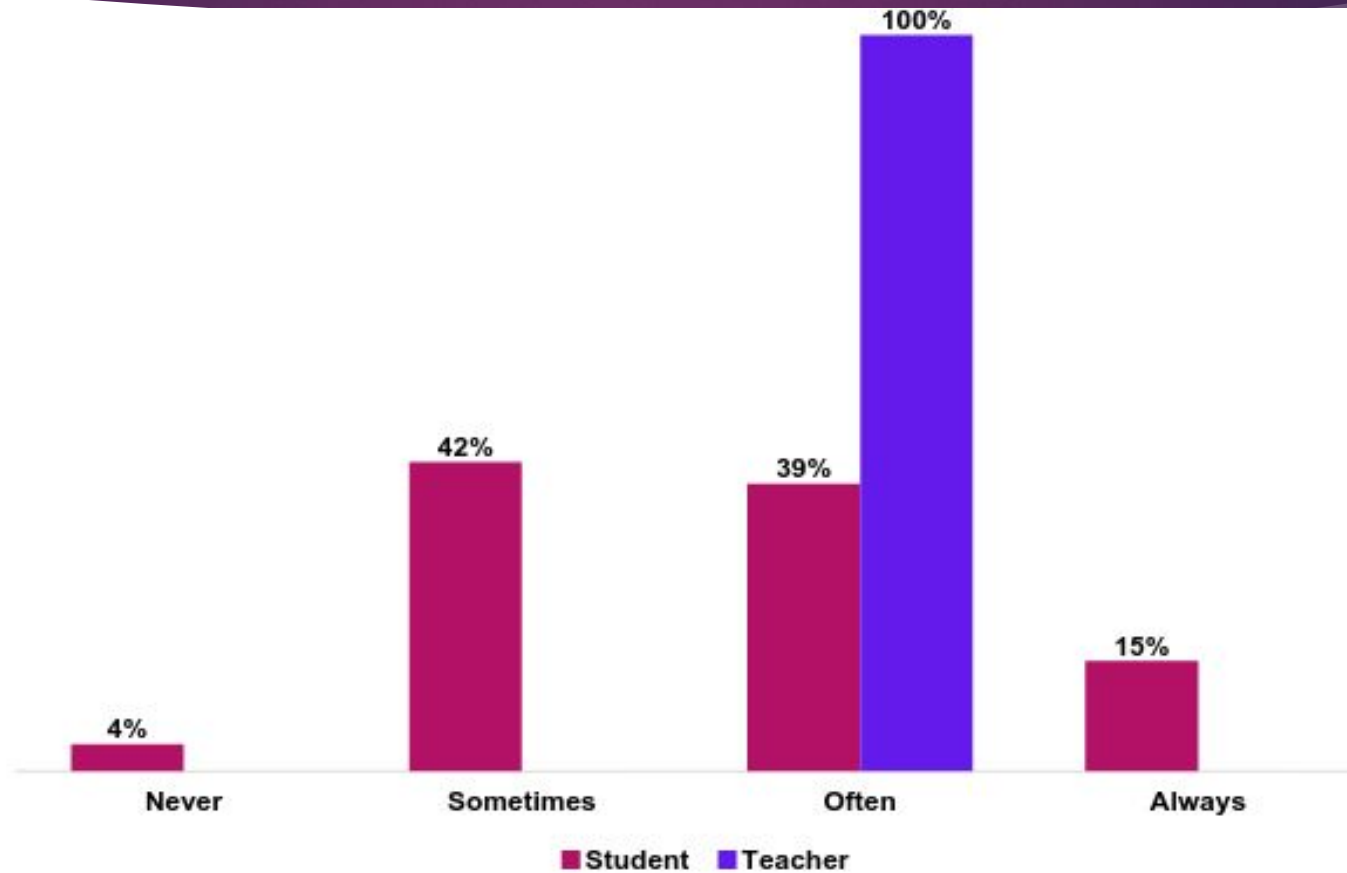
Caring Adult-Critical Attributes

- ▶ Someone who listens to the students' side of the story
- ▶ Pay attention to personal details about work style
- ▶ Ask questions to see how students feel, based off of students' behavior
- ▶ Somebody who can take time out of their day to talk to students
- ▶ Working together on weaknesses
- ▶ Asking the "why" behind a behavior
- ▶ Regularly check in with students
- ▶ Teachers see students as colleagues

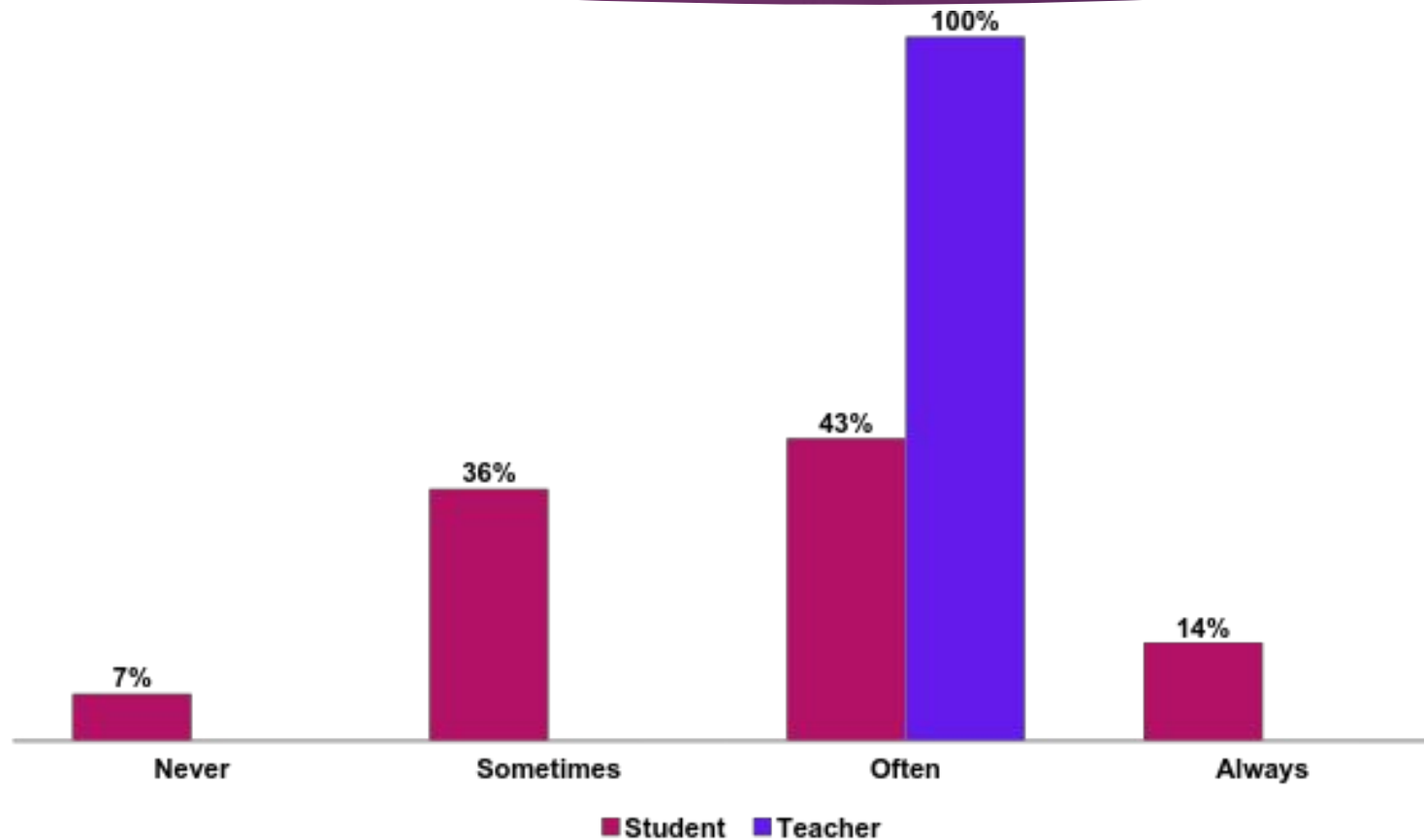
Methods

- ▶ Teacher survey-71% response rate

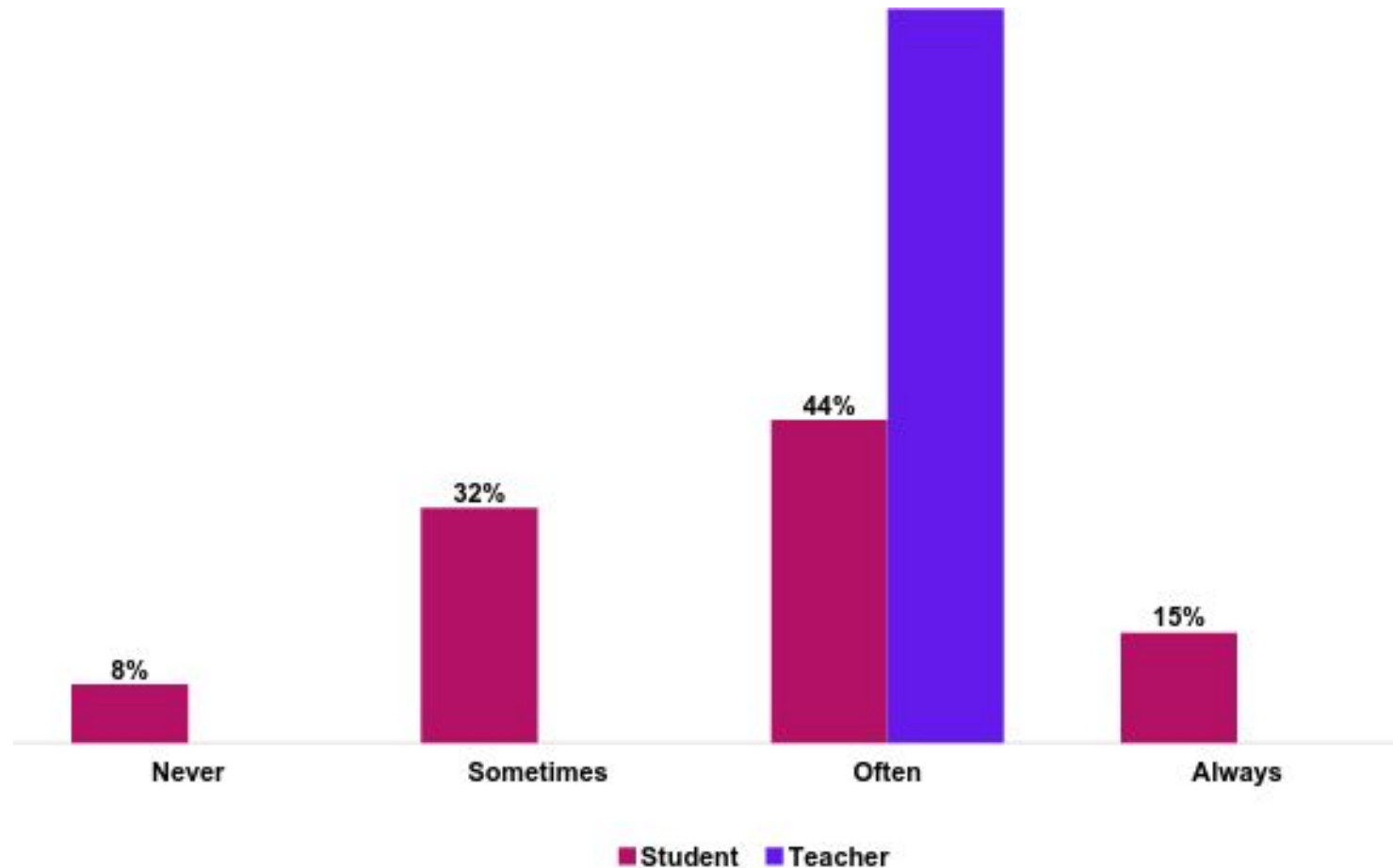
See Students' Viewpoint as Truth



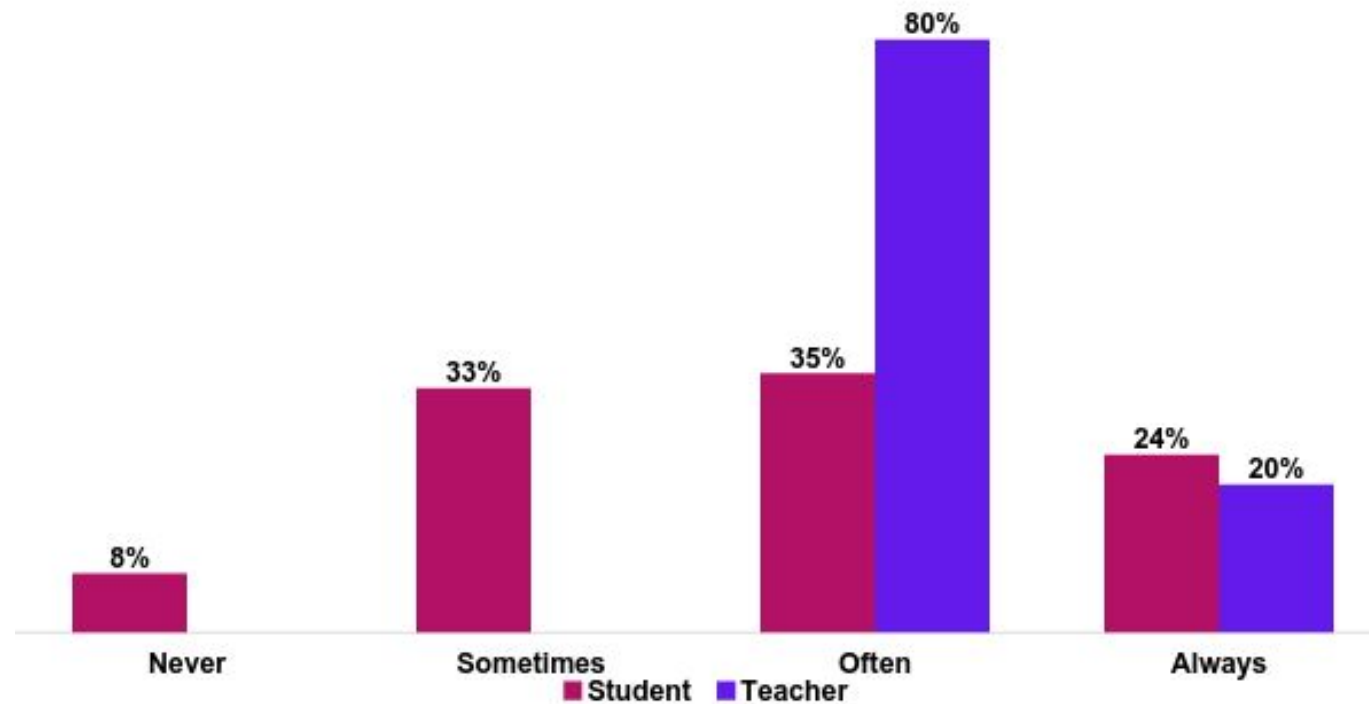
Adjust Classwork to Student Learning Styles



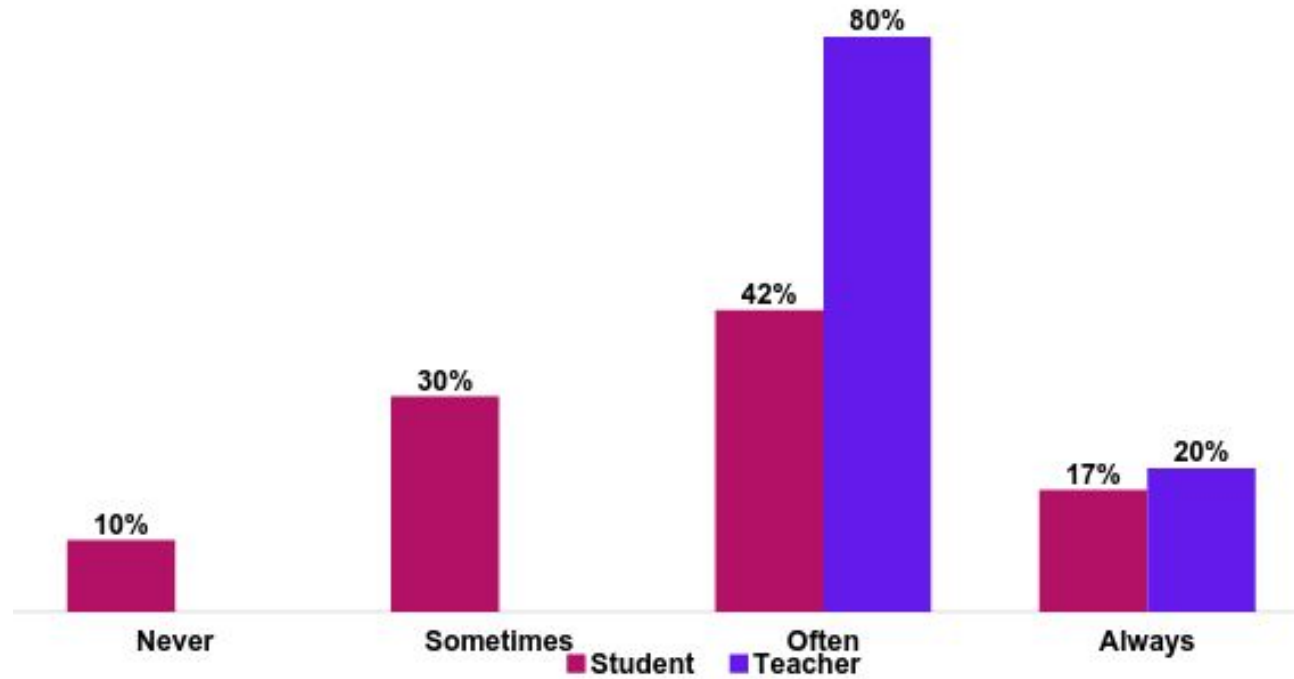
Resolve Issues in an Effective Manner



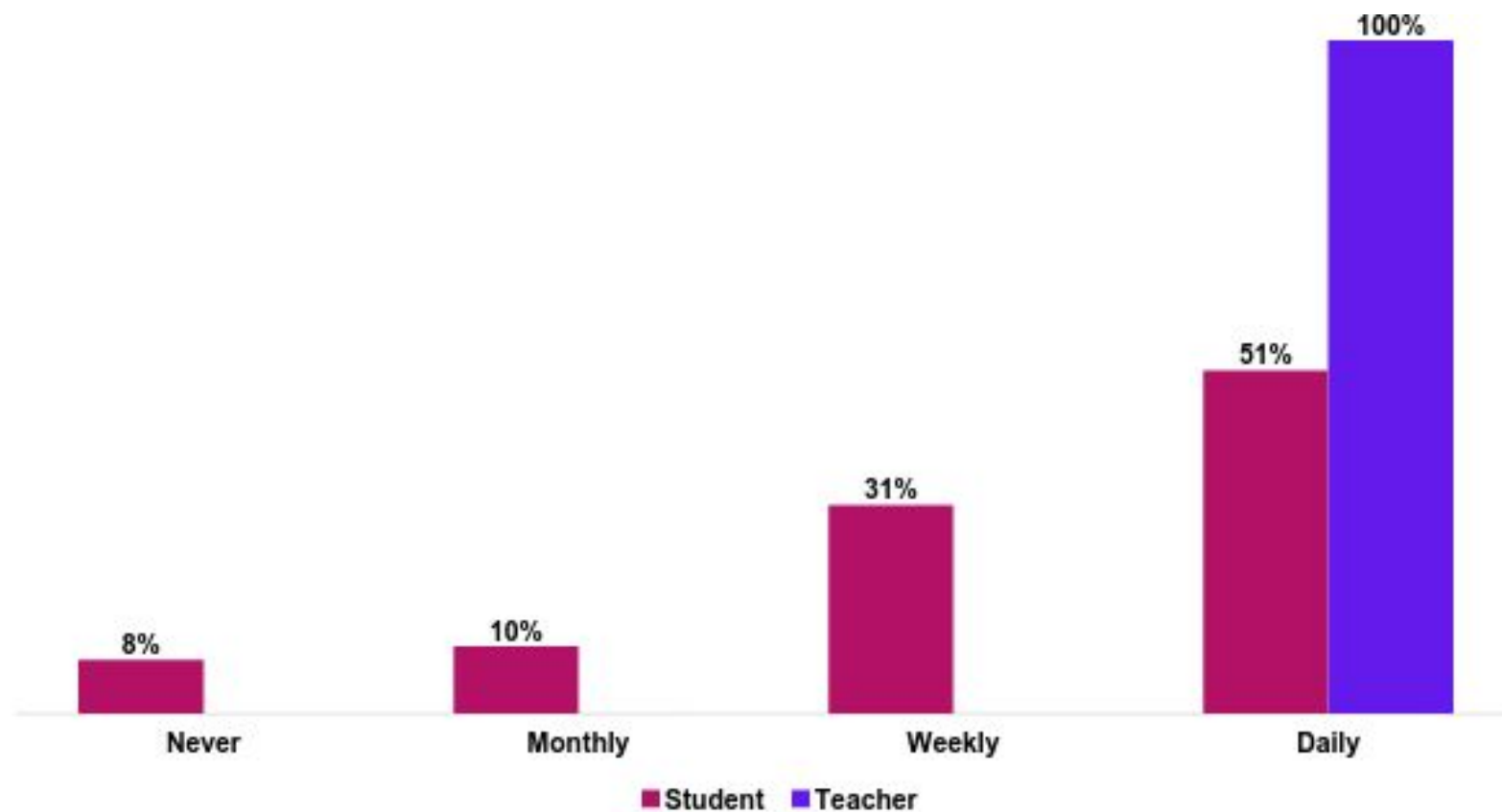
Students Enjoy Being in Classroom



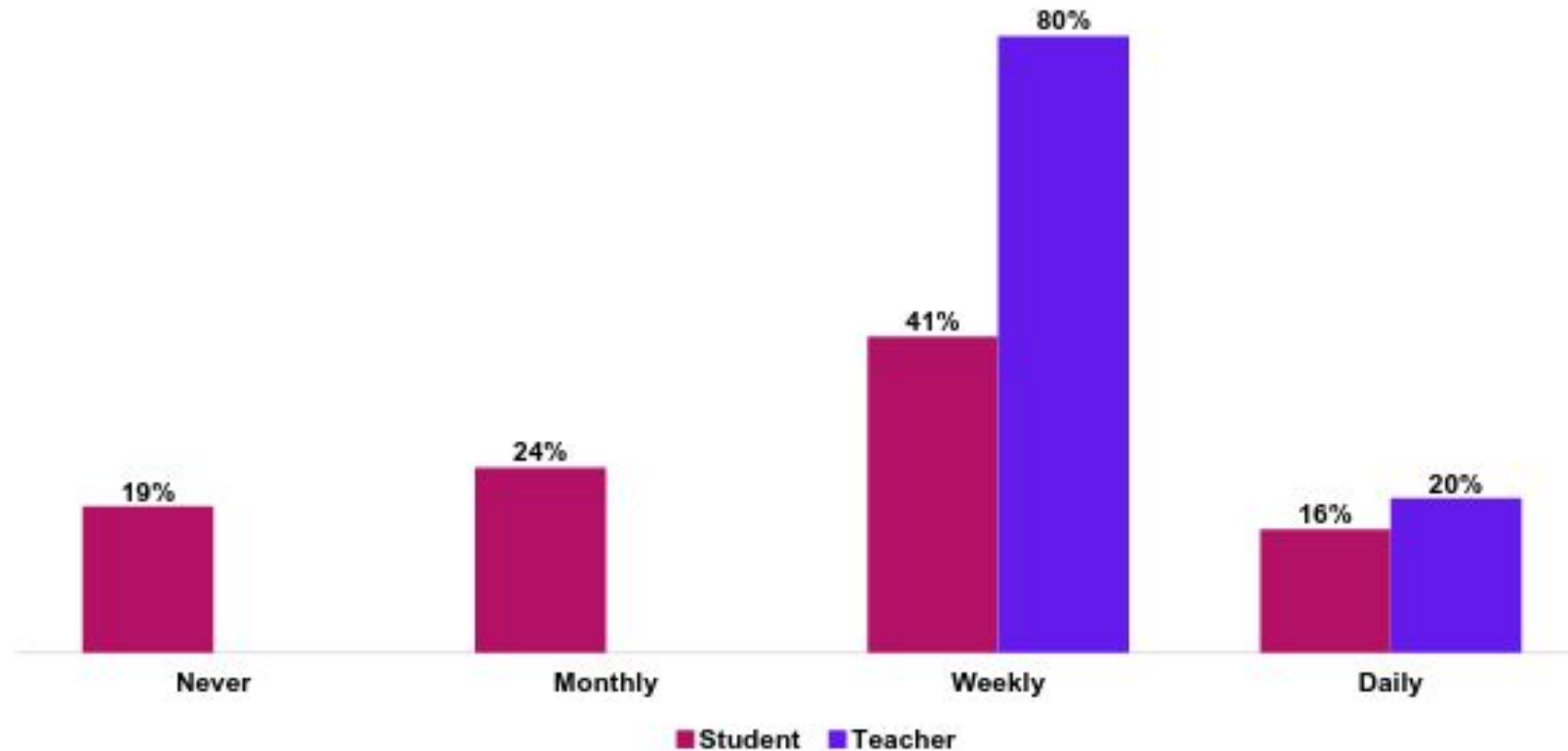
Seek Out Root Issue When Student Behavior or Body Language is Off
